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WHC-FRM-EARLY REVIEW PLAN

The purpose of an Early Review Plan (ERP) is to:

- Summarise a worker's health issues and responsibilities for ongoing monitoring, early medical review, treatment, and
- Identify and approve any related restrictions on an aspect of a workers' normal role.

The **results** of this review (in a report from their treating Doctor or Specialist) must be submitted to your Order 43 Doctor or Coal Services Health (CSH) to satisfy the Order 43 review requirements. The Order 43 Doctor will issue an **Order 43 medical assessment review report**. This report must be submitted to WHC via the Onsite portal following the review.

In cases where a restriction applies, the ERP must be submitted to medicals@whitehavencoal.com.au for approval.

The worker is to sign this plan to acknowledge his/her accountability and inform WHC of any changes in treatment or other controls that may influence their fitness for work or alter this plan.

Once the ERP has been approved, if required for an induction you will be required to upload the signed ERP to the Early Review competency and full Order 43 Medical report to the Coal Medical Group (NSW) competency.

Following the medical review with the treating Doctor, the results must be provided to your Company's Order 43 Doctor to review. Following this review, an Order 43 Medical Assessment Review Report will be issued. This must be uploaded to Pegasus. If the certificate states that further review is required, a new ERP must also be uploaded to the Pegasus portal.
