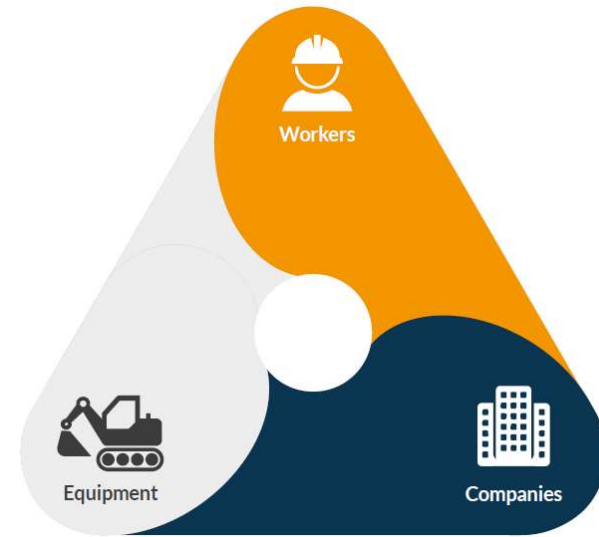

Why Use a DeskTop Kiosk?



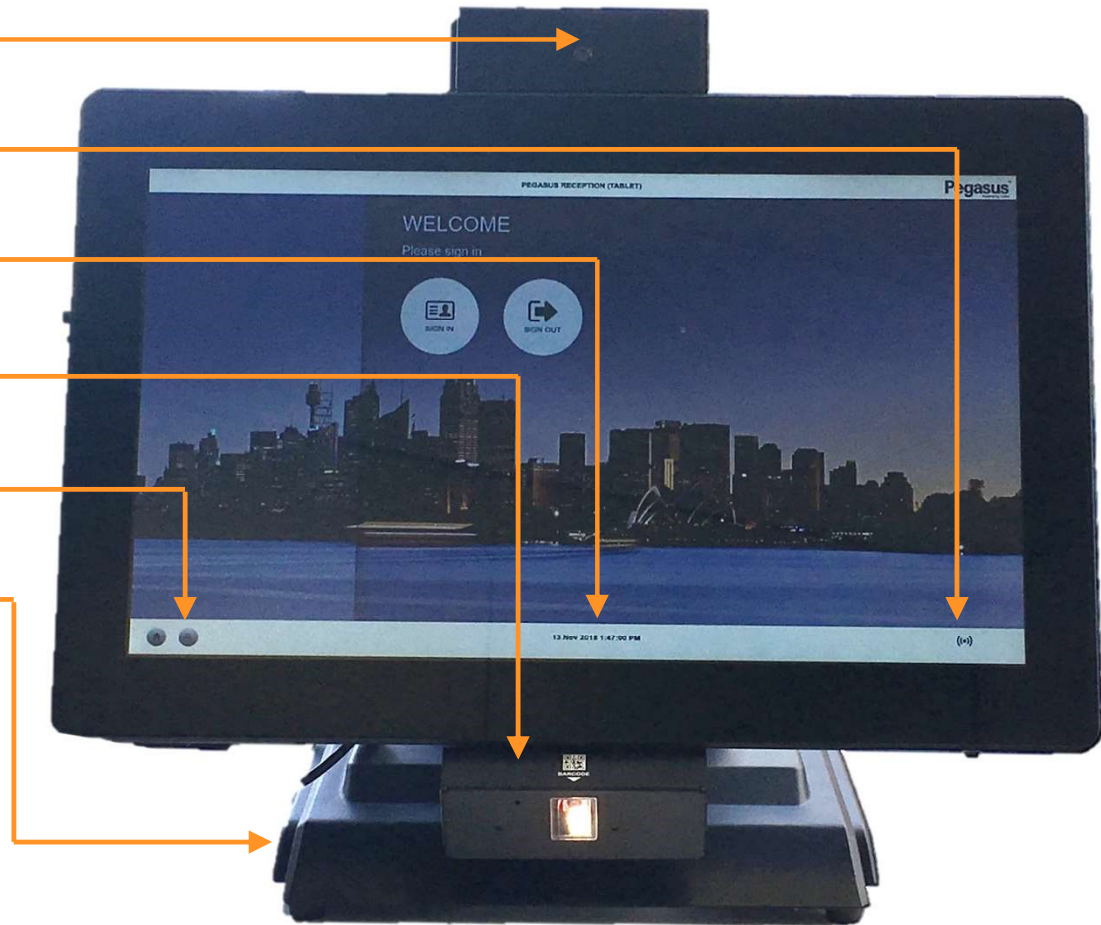
- Smooth Design – Touchscreen

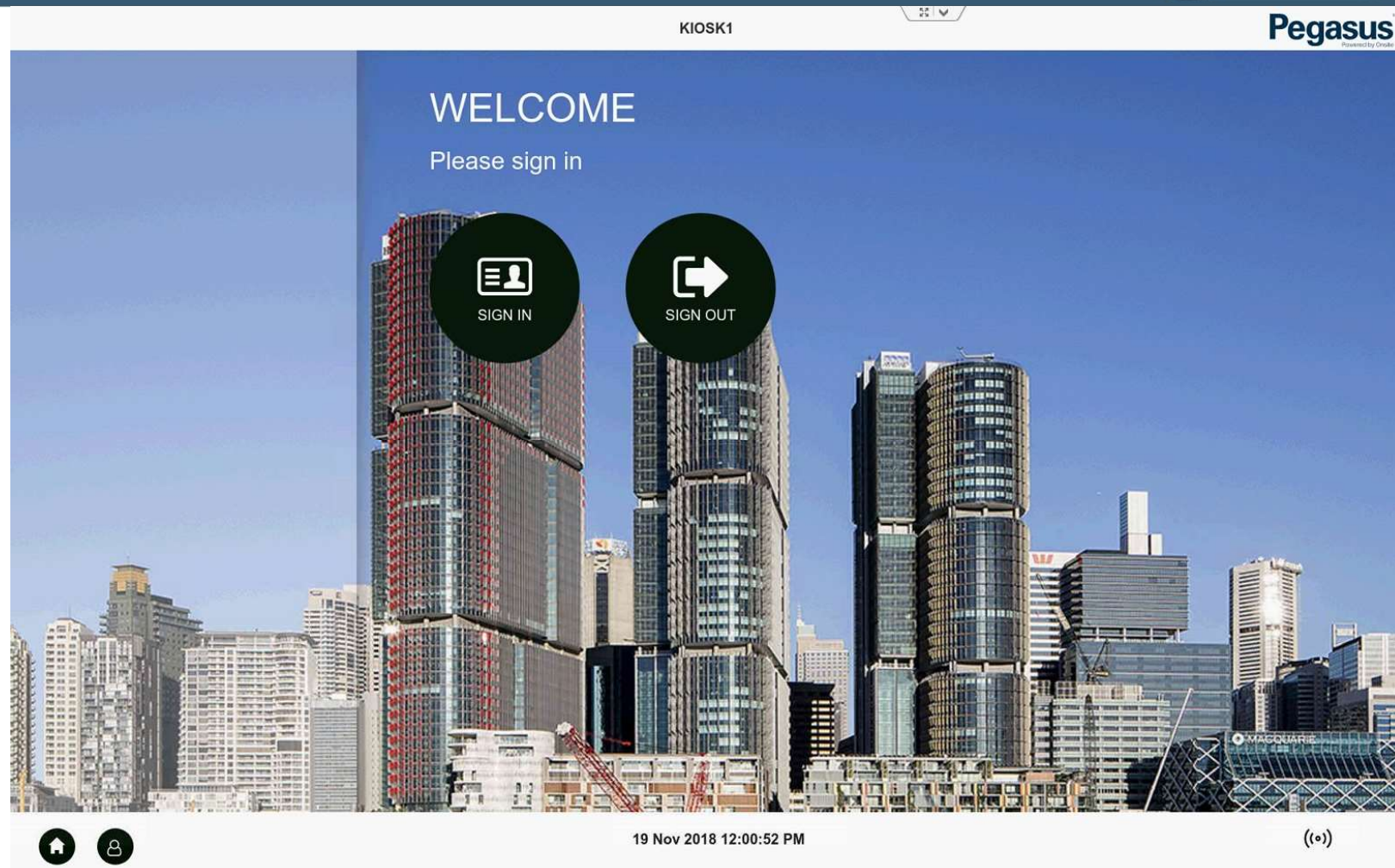

Sign In / Out Process



- Tap Proximity reader when on the Welcome screen if you have your card. This will start the Sign in/out process depending on your status at site.
- Press SIGN IN or SIGN OUT when you don't have your card.
- Press SIGN IN if you are starting work at site. If you are a visitor a sticker will be printed.
- Press SIGN OUT to complete your logout process with site and be recorded as leaving.



Sign In / Visitor Screen

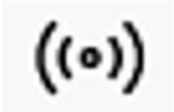



- Cardholders: If you have a card you can tap on here as well. If you don't have your card, enter in your number manually.
- If you are a visitor, use the bottom three fields to enter in your details.
- Ensure that Full Company name, First Name and Last Name and 10 Digit Phone Number are all entered.
- Visitors, when signing out, use the ID number on top of sticker. Or use same details you used to login, to log out here. The system will match you.
