Logpoint & Peripheral Hardware Quick Setup Guide

Quick Setup Guide

- 1. Place Logpoint stand on flat surface.
- 2. Attach the Stylus Pen chord to lower protruding mount peg on the stand.
- 3. Align the 3 pegs on mount plate with the holes in the rear of the Logpoint and slide on.
- 4. Place UPS in close proximity & behind the Logpoint then connect it to mains power.
- 5. UPS sockets to be used are marked "Battery backup plus surge protection" (behind the yellow tag).
- 6. Place the Blue 3G Modem within 1 metre of Logpoint and attach on the 2 fibre antennas.
- 7. Connect the black Cross-over Ethernet cable from the 3G Modem to the Logpoint port labelled LAN.
- 8. Connect the 3G Modem power cable to the UPS and the modem inlet. This will "boot" the modem.
- 9. Place Sticker Printer beside to Logpoint.
- 10. Connect the parallel cable from Printer to the Logpoint port labelled "Printer".
- 11. Connect the printer power supply & appliance cable to the printer (small round socket) & the UPS.
- 12. Turn the Printer on. The power switch is on the rear of the printer.
- 13. Place the Barcode Reader close to the Logpoint. Connect the USB Port to the Logpoint.
 - Double sided tape can be used to secure the bar code reader to the bench
- 14. The Visitor Camera foot plate slides into the recess at the top of the Logpoint, fitting between the front chassis plastic and glass insert plate.
- 15. Connect the Visitor Camera to the USB Port on the Logpoint.
- 16. Connect the Logpoint appliance power cable from the socket at top left hand side behind the printer socket to UPS.
- 17. Turn on power to the Logpoint. The Logpoint power button is on the bottom left side of the screen.
 - NB: The modem should be fully booted with an RSSI & DCD green LED lights on.
- 18. The Logpoint will follow a visual boot sequence to a welcome screen and be ready to use.
- 19. Internet connection is confirmed by the word "Online" in the top right corner under the clock.
 - If the Welcome screen has a button labelled "Operational Mode" press this button to move the Logpoint into operational mode.
- 20. The Logpoint is now ready to use.


