

Using Data Analytics

Data Analytics brings the information in the Pegasus Client Portal to life. Be empowered to build your own insights.

Manage your operations into the future by acting on the trends and data you see today.

User access and reporting is configured to match your business needs, to analyse data on companies, workers and sites.

Real-time data at your fingertips includes analysis of roles, logpoints, attendance and competencies.

You control the Data Analytics interface, to discover the "Why" in your Data.

- Utilise predictive analysis to find key information
- Access an at-a-glance video of your entire workforce
- Search by role, competency, person type, site, status etc







Using Data Analytics - Example

Open a module to investigate e.g. Onsite Now

All items on page are clickable and interactable

- Left or Right clicking on items such as graphs, and content will allow you
 to drill down into the relevant data, or filter out content based upon
 your focus.
- Data displayed will change its view, colour, chart data, or list of results in real time.
- Refresh the page if you need to reset it all to the default view.






Accessing Data Analytics

Analytics Icon will be visible in the Pegasus Client Portal

If icon is transparent, then it is not currently enabled for your Site or Realm

- Data Analytics requires a Pegasus Account Manager to enable this feature before it will be selectable in the Pegasus Client Portal.
- Otherwise it will show as transparent and an option to Learn More will appear as you hover over it.

Accessing Analytics

Access is granted from Onsite Track Easy

Navigate to Person > Users

Open the User Profile you wish to give access to in the relevant Site/Realm

Click on the Rights tab

Scroll to bottom and click "edit"

Under Analytics Report Role Select the level you wish to grant the Site/Realm user

Scroll to the bottom and select save to apply

- Four levels of Analytics Report Role are available
- None Access Denied message will appear when trying to access
- User Minimal modules are available
- Supervisor More modules available
- Manager All modules available including Service Reports and TNA Compliance options
- Modules for each levels are configured and managed by your Pegasus Account Manager.

Will be tailored to your client colours and branding

- View will be different depending upon your configuration within Pegasus. Not all icons will be available as custom reports are configured for individual Clients
- Depending upon user level, module icons will also appear different than what may appear in this guide





Navigating & Utilizing Data Analytics - Top Bar

Client icon exists here, visual only The Top Bar is for navigating certain tools available Service Report a icon appears at Manager level. depending upon your Links to Support Ticket system (RT) that Pegasus will use to manage permission level in Analytics your enquiries. Will allow you to open a report view to see support ticket volume and statuses (open, resolved). See your Pegasus Account Manager for more details. By default, Service Reports and TNA Compliance are TNA Compliance will provide a report view where you can see and manage your view on that data. See role percentages, number of roles, unavailable for Users and and filter by locations for example. Manipulate the data in real time. Navigating & Utilizing Data Analytics - Available Tools

Use these Tools to navigate and manage inside Analytics

These are the common tools that will appear on all pages and modules

Some are context sensitive, so will interact slightly different depending upon the module you are working in.



- Selecting Multiple items is the same as Microsoft Office, you hold down CTRL and click on the items one at a time to select, or use the Search to filter similar to Microsoft Excel
- Clear selection icon will flush out your filtered results back to the default for that section

Navigating & Utilizing Data Analytics - Available Tools


Use of the More Option button will change depending on the context in which section it is being used

When used in a filter, the sort options appear, as well as view as a table.

Export Data icon opens a new window to allow you to select format (xlsx, csv)

Focus Mode will allow you to expand that filter item to see more data and make it easier to see/select results in a larger view

Back Arrow appears in each module to return to main Analytics screen.








Navigating & Utilizing Data Analytics - Available Tools

The Spotlight tool will highlight an area of the Analytics screen

It can be used when presenting with others in a meeting, or when taking screenshots of data and you wish to highlight critical information



 Appears on most sections inside Analytics. Can be used on the Module Itself before opening one, or on various elements of data on screen, such as graphs, charts, data tables, result boxes.
